**To download .exe file:**

[www.oracle.com](http://www.oracle.com) → Product → Java → Download Java (At Right Corner) → Java 8 → Windows → Download → [jdk-8u311-windows-i586.exe](#) (For-32bits) **and** [jdk-8u311-windows-x64.exe](#) (For-64 bits) → Tick in check box → Download jdk → Oracle account sign in ( User name as email address, & Password) → Sign in → (.exe Download start)

Double click on downloaded file → Next → Next → Next → Close

**To setup the environment variables:**

**For Variable Name:** This PC/My Computer → Properties → Advanced System Settings → Advanced → Environment variables → System Variables → New → Variable Name (JAVA\_HOME)

**For Variable Value:** Access installation path of jdk folder

C drive → Program files (for 64-bit) **and** program files x86 (for 32-bit) → Java → jdk 1.8.0\_311 → **Copy** path from address bar → **Paste** into Variable Value → Ok

**To add path:** Access installation path of bin folder

C drive → Program files (for 64-bit) **and** program files x86 (for 32-bit) → Java → jdk 1.8.0\_311 → bin → **Copy** path from address bar → System Variables → Path (Double Click) → New → **Paste** → Ok → Ok → Ok
